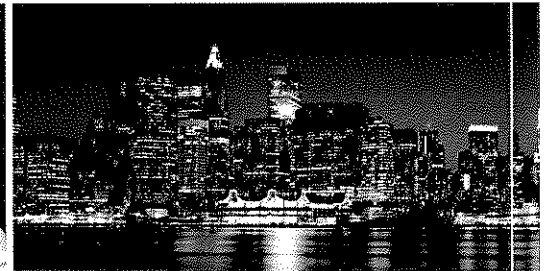
The First Annual
