See Westlaw at CO-LEGIS or Lexis at CO-CALS.
ADVANCE MATERIALS—current information on legislative session.	<u>Red Book</u> (LexisNexis)—lists legislation passed during session by House/Senate bills and code citation; available after governor acts on all legislation. Published at the end of a session. NO TEXT—annual paperbound pamphlet. See Colorado General Assembly Home Page: (http://www.leg.state.co.us/). Click <u>Session Laws</u> – <u>Red Book</u> links.	<u>West's Colorado Revised Statutes Annotated: Interim Annotation Service</u> —paperbound pamphlets of annotations supplementing pocket parts; published during current session.

1. Current citations for an older statute -- (e.g., 1963 compilation).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LexisNexis: N to Z Index volume (Comparative Tables). • West: Not available.
2. Definitions – (e.g., air pollutant).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LexisNexis: N to Z Index (“Words and Phrases” section). • West: General Index – M to Z (“Words and Phrases” section).
3. Popular names-- (e.g., Air Pollution Prevention and Control Act).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LexisNexis: N to Z Tables Index volume (“Short Titles and Popular Names” section). • West: General Index M-Z volume (“Popular Name Table” in back of volume). <p><u>Shepard’s Acts and Cases by Popular Names</u> (Level 3 Reference KF 90.S54).</p>
4. Statute citations -- Colo. Rev. Stat. § 25-7-101 (2007)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LexisNexis: Title numbers on volume spines. • West: Title & article numbers on most volume spines.
5. Statute titles by subject-- (e.g., Health).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LexisNexis: Subjects on volume spines; 43 titles/subjects listed in front of each volume. • West: Subjects on volume spines; 43 titles/subjects listed in front of each volume.
6. Subjects -- (e.g., Air Quality Control Program).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LexisNexis Index volumes -- A to M & N to Z. • West: General Index volumes--A to L & M to Z.
