

CLASS OF 2023 EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS 10 MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION



SALARY INFORMATION

Information is based on full-time salaries that were reported or publicly available.

ALL REPORTED FULL-TIME SALARIES

While we ask all graduates who are employed in full-time positions to provide their salaries, salary information is more difficult to obtain than employment status. Our salary statistics are based on obtaining full time salaries from 76% of the class, which were reported or publicly available.

Equation: 198 known salaries divided by 261 JD graduates in the class = 76% of the class.


PRIVATE SECTOR

This includes positions in law firms, business and industry (based on the 110 salaries reported or publicly available for graduates employed in the private sector, which represents 42% of the class.)

Equation: 110 known private sector salaries divided by 261 JD graduates in the class = 42% of the class.

PUBLIC SERVICE

This includes government positions, judicial clerkships, academic posts, or positions with non-profit advocacy or cause-oriented organizations (based on the 88 salaries reported or publicly available for graduates employed in public service, which represents 34% of the class.)

Equation: 88 known public sector salaries divided by 261 JD graduates in the class = 34% of the class

GRADUATES EMPLOYED IN PROFESSIONAL POSITIONS

**Of 261 graduates, 255 sought employment of which 234 (91.8%) are employed in professional positions, which include jobs requiring bar admission, where the JD provides an advantage, or where professional skills or training are required. We also count university-funded positions where graduates perform legal work for judges and government agencies.
