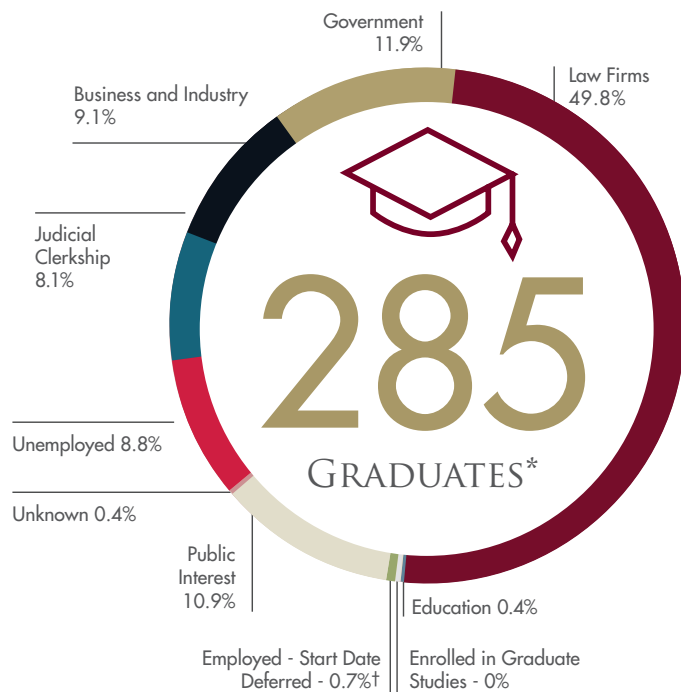

CLASS OF 2025 EMPLOYMENT STATISTICS 10 MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION



SALARY INFORMATION

Information is based on full-time salaries that were reported or publicly available.

ALL REPORTED FULL-TIME SALARIES

While we ask all graduates who are employed in full-time, long-term positions to provide their salaries, salary information is more difficult to obtain than employment status.

Our salary statistics are based on obtaining full-time, long-term salaries from 67% of the class, which were reported or publicly available.

Equation: 190 known salaries divided by 285 JD graduates in the class = 67% of the class.

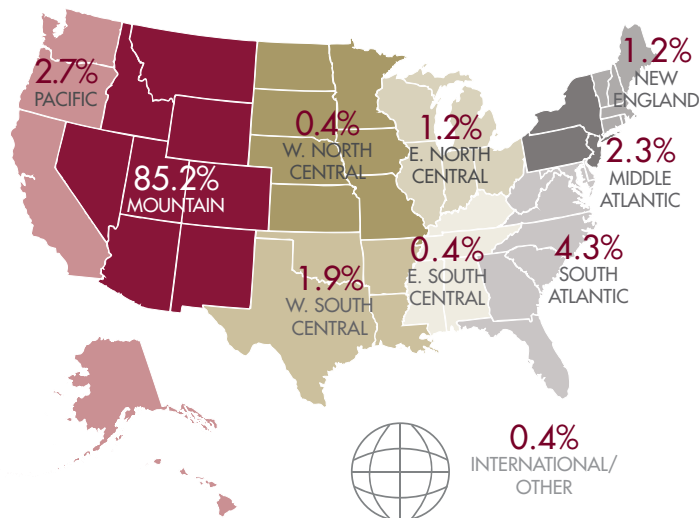
PRIVATE SECTOR

This includes positions in law firms, business and industry (based on the 119 salaries reported or publicly available for graduates employed in the private sector, which represents 42% of the class.)

Equation: 119 known private sector salaries divided by 285 JD graduates in the class = 42% of the class.

PUBLIC SERVICE

This includes government positions, judicial clerkships, academic posts, or positions with non-profit advocacy or cause-oriented organizations (based on the 71 salaries reported or publicly available for graduates employed in public service, which represents 25% of the class.)

Equation: 71 known public service salaries divided by 285 JD graduates in the class = 25% of the class

GRADUATES EMPLOYED IN PROFESSIONAL POSITIONS

^{**}Of 285 graduates, 281 sought employment, of which 256 (91.1%) are employed in professional positions. This includes jobs requiring bar admission, where the JD provides an advantage, or where professional skills, supervisory duties, or the regular use of professional judgement are required. We also count university-funded positions where graduates perform legal work for judges and government agencies.
