IP & Tech Law Certificate Experiential Requirement

The IP & Technology Law Certificate requires that students complete two credits or 100 hours of an experiential learning opportunity. This requirement can be satisfied in any of the following ways:

1. At least two (2) IP & Tech Law Capstone or Practicum courses;
2. An externship approved by an IP & Tech Law Faculty Director and coordinated through the Legal Externship Program where the student works in IP and/or technology law [Note: Up to 3 externship credits (excluding seminar) can count for the certificate, if you complete an externship of more than 3 credit hours then only 3 of those credits will count];
3. Another experiential learning opportunity of at least 100 clock hours as approved by an IP & Tech Law Faculty Director.

* If completing an externship or internship, fill out the Externship/Internship Employer Form on the following page. Please submit this form to the Registrar's office when you apply to graduate with the certificate.

Note that students may need to take additional approved elective courses to meet the minimum 15 credit requirement for the certificate.
