TO QUALIFY STUDENTS MUST:

1. Complete two (2) of the following core courses:

 - ☐ Introduction to Intellectual Property (LAWS 4310)
 - ☐ Law & Emerging Technologies (LAWS 4376)
 - ☐ Patent Law (LAWS 4096)
 - ☐ Privacy Law (LAWS 4008)
 - ☐ Trademark Law (LAWS 4115)
2. Complete two (2) additional courses (either core or courses from the list below):
 - ☐ Antitrust and Unfair Competition (LAWS 4070)
 - ☐ Employment Law Survey (LAWS 4205)
 - ☐ Entertainment Law (LAWS 4215)
 - ☐ Media Law (LAWS 4433)
 - ☐ Patent Litigation (LAWS 4483)
 - ☐ Patent Prosecution (LAWS 4474)
 - ☐ Directed research (LAWS 4999) as approved by Faculty Director
 - ☐ Or, relevant Special Topics courses (LAWS 4700-4709) or any other relevant course as approved by Faculty Director. Approved courses include: Cybersecurity Practicum; Law & Innovation Lab (up to 3 credits).
3. Complete an experiential learning opportunity, through:
 - a. Two credits of IP & Technology Law (IPTL) Capstone or Practicum courses; or
 - b. Up to 3 credits (excluding seminar) from an externship approved by one of the IPTL Faculty Directors and coordinated through the Legal Externship Program, or
 - c. Another experiential learning opportunity of at least 100 clock hours as approved by an IPTL Faculty Director.
4. Complete a **minimum of 15 credits** in the IPTL curriculum. Note that some students may need to take additional elective courses to meet the 15 credit hour requirement.

To declare your intent to complete the certificate program:

Please complete **this form** to formally declare the certificate. The deadline to declare is the end of the add/drop period in the semester preceding that of your intended graduation, but we encourage you to declare as soon as you decide you intend to complete the certificate. In addition to declaring the certificate, you must also apply to graduate with the certificate at the same time that you apply to graduate with the JD degree.
